



TEAM PLAYER PICTURE RULES

All coaches are to take a picture of each of their players along the following guidelines:

- Photographs can be printed but should fit in the square on the FSYFL stipulated Hard Cards.
- Player photographs can be taken with the Player in any type of jersey or t-shirt. A number is NOT necessary as the FSYFL certifies the player number with a separate stamps on the players hard card.
- The players FULL face with some of the shoulders must be taken in the photograph.
- The photographs can be taken with an ordinary digital camera and then printed for placement onto the Hard Card ID and inserted into the Coaches Team Folder.



Please Note: These pictures show a sample with players wearing jerseys, however numbers on the photograph are NOT necessary

- The Hard Cards with player photographs will then be used to verify each player at the game check in prior to each game of the season.
- Once the Player has been certified with weight, payment and documentation at their 1st game the FSYFL will certify the photograph by stamping the photograph in the corner overlapping the Hard Card. This will not be able to be changed for the entire season.
