



FSYFL Field Audits

The FSYFL provides for a fairly stringent certification process. However, coaches should be informed that in addition to this certification process, the Certifications department will conduct two types of field audits in a season.

a) *A Blind Audit* – Certifications directors will stand on the game sideline and check numbers and counts of players on the field against the numbers/counts registered for the team at the check in office.

b) *A Spot Field Audit* – These checks will be random. The game will be stopped and players will be lined up on their respective 30 yard lines without helmets and the FSYFL Certifications team will check players by their file folders.

Please Note: Violations of the certification rules in any way will not be tolerated, and will result in forfeitures and/or suspensions. Coaches and Parents need to understand that these field checks will be taking place based purely on a lottery system conducted by the FSYFL and are not based on any information to the contrary. If a team comes up for a random audit it DOES NOT mean that they are guilty or in any way in violation.
