### Team Name Legends

This is the week that this team will travel

This is the code by which a team is identified. If an organization has multiple teams they are usually named with the same code for each division.

This is the FSYFL conference that a team belongs to. Teams complete all across Florida in the regular season but in the Conference for the playoffs. conference teams in the playoffs. Your record is based on ALL your games NOT just your conference games, but there is a tie breaker that takes into account the Conference percentage...so conference games are important.

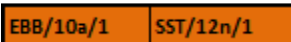


THIS MEANS YOU HAVE A BYE WEEK

**NC** THIS SIGN MEANS THAT THE GAME YOU ARE PLAYING **DOES NOT COUNT – NEITHER THE WIN OR THE POINTS COUNT FOR YOU, HOWEVER EVERYTHING COUNTS FOR THE OTHER TEAM.** Sometime in order to get a team their required 7 games the schedule has to have some teams play 8 games.

## Learning to Read the Schedule

### Step 1 – UNDERSTAND THE TEAM CODES

You need to understand all the team codes so that you can know which team you are playing when you are on your schedule line. i.e. “OWB” means the Oceanway Buccaneers and “POH1” (Port Orange Hawks Team # 1)

### Step 2 – FIND MY LINE

You need to first look at your division schedule (i.e. MITEY MITES, PEEWEE etc) and then find your team LINE on the schedule.

EXAMPLE: If I am the Creeks Knights I am looking at my line of the schedule. In this example I play “OWB” (Oceanway Buccaneers) on the 1<sup>st</sup> week (Feb 18<sup>th</sup>), and have a double header on the 2<sup>nd</sup> week (Feb 25<sup>th</sup>) against “NSB2” (New Smyrna Cudas) and the “POH1” (Port Orange Hawks 1) etc as you go down the line.

**STAY ON YOUR LINE ALL THE WAY ACROSS TO SEE YOUR GAMES**

### Step 3 – UNDERSTAND THE CODE FOR YOUR GAME

You need to understand what each code in the game box means.

Example: This Code OWB/8a/1 means that I am playing the “OWB” Oceanway Buccaneers team at 8am on Field 1

### Step 4 – UNDERSTAND THE COLOR COADES FOR THE FIELDS

You need to understand that each field has its own color code and the color of your box on that game day denotes the field that you will play at for that game.

EXAMPLE #1:

These are each of the field colors. **THEY ARE PLACED ON THE TOP OF EVERY DIVISION SCHEDULE.**

EXAMPLE #2

Because you can see from the codes above that St Pete is PINK and Brandon is BROWN, you know that you are going to play the AJD (Azalea Junkyards Dawgs) at 8am on Field #1 at St Pete and then play ELR (East Lake Raptors) at 2pm on Field 2 in Brandon

AJD/8a/1

ELR2/2p/2

**REMEMBER TO READ YOUR SCHEDULE YOU SIMPLY STAY ON YOUR LINE ALL THE WAY ACROSS. DO NOT START GOING AROUND THE SCHEDULE LOOKING FOR YOUR CODE...YOU GAMES ARE ALL IN THE ONE ROW**
